



1.4.1 Department-wise student feedback and action taken.

We consider the student feedback as a vital source of information to improve upon ourselves. We take them seriously and try to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. Here are a few suggestions received department-wise, over the past five years by our students and the action taken to meet their demands.

Department of History: Most of our students hail from neighbouring villages and haven't visited places. Institution obtains feedback on the academic performance and ambience of the institution from various stakeholders, such as Students, Teachers, Employers, Alumni etc. and action taken report on the feedback is made available on institutional website (Yes or No)

The feedback from the students is generally taken every year to gauge their level of satisfaction on various issues pertaining to their academic progress and performance and the infrastructures provided.

This semester, a total of 317 responses were received. By and large, the students seem to be satisfied with the various issues we had listed out in the questionnaire, like syllabus covered, preparedness of the teachers, etc. However, a thin minority of students seem to be dissatisfied with certain aspects. We should be accountable for every single issue and must provide the maximum satisfaction to our students in the teaching, administrative and infrastructural aspects in our college.

The IQAC, with the Principal, has taken suitable action regarding the complaints raised by the students. Since the identity of the students is kept confidential, they do not hesitate to furnish a frank and free opinion.

The issues generally fall under three categories; Academic administrative and infrastructure related. If the portions are either not covered or not taught to the satisfaction of an average student, the concerned teacher will be summoned to the principal's chamber, and an in-camera interaction will be held with the Co-Ordinator. If the teacher is a new recruit or less experienced, the head of the department will guide him to improvise his/ her performance. If the complaint is against a senior teacher (the chances of which are very few and far between). Moreover, that part of the lesson is taught again by the same teacher or by a senior teacher. To make this possible, feed back is taken a little while before the completion of the academic semester.

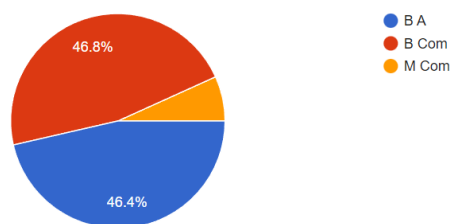
The students need not wait for the end of the term to file their complaints. The students have a fair access to teachers and grievance cells to resolve their immediate problems and requirements all through the academic year. The teachers assist the office staff in making the administrative work smoother and reducing the anxiety of the students.

If the complaints are about the infrastructural requirements, the IQAC and the Principal weigh the demand judiciously and arrive at a solution. The IQAC seeks the support of the management to fix such issues.

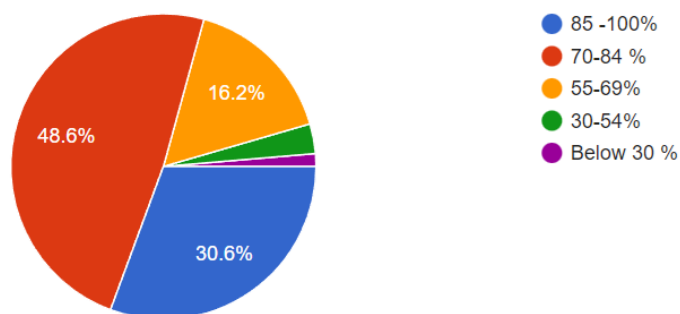

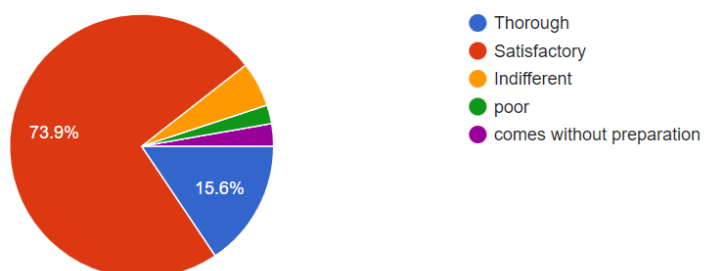

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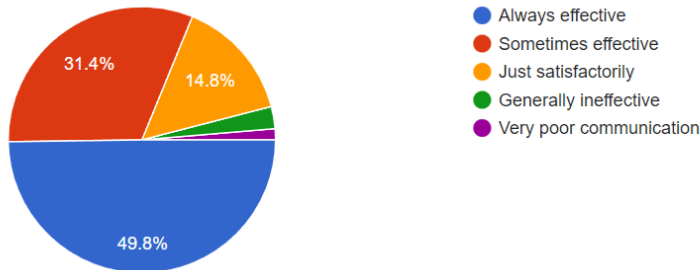

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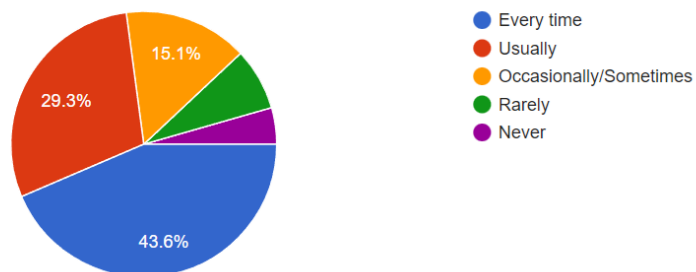

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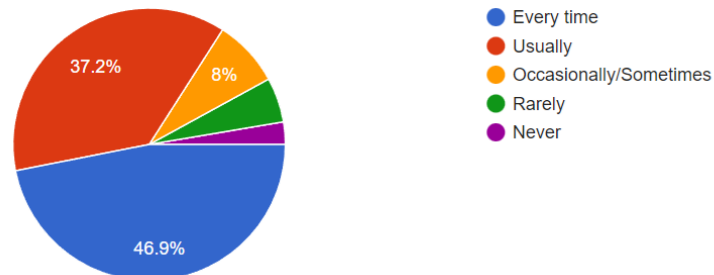

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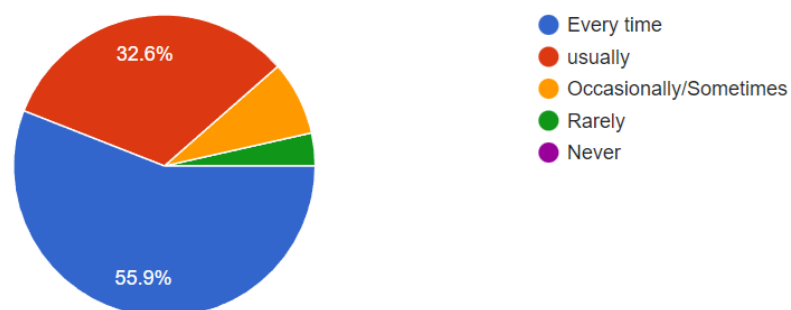

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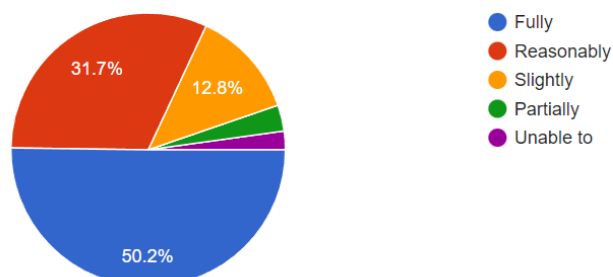

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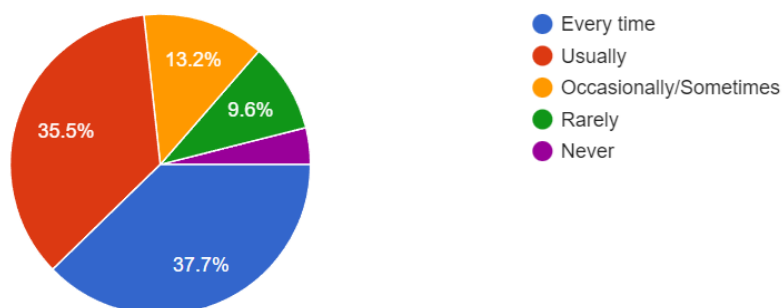

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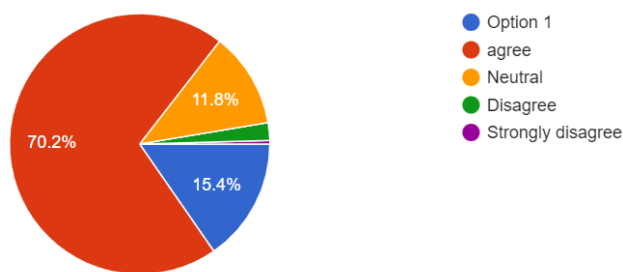

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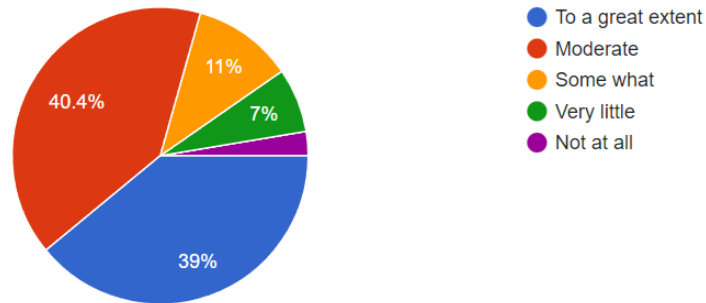

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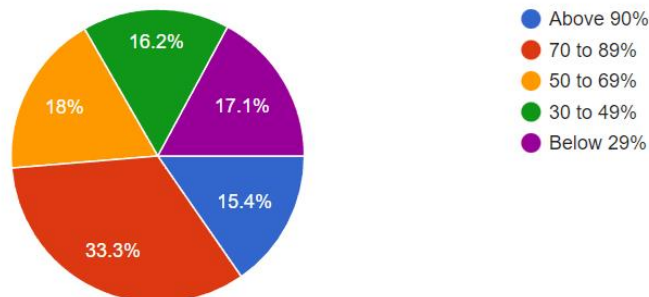

16) What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

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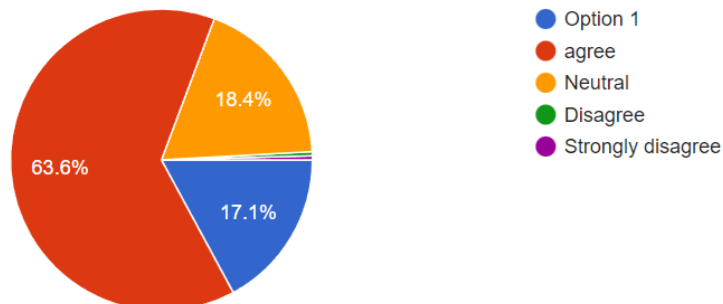
