Allot appropriate time to answer 2/5/10 mark questions. And concentrate on your handwriting.

SV: All you need is concentration and memory. Don't be a book-worm. Enjoy your life but know your responsibilities. Put all your efforts. Time is precious. Jump into the field for which you have fascination. Not all students can afford college education. Make the best of it. Read at least 2-3 hours per day, from two months before exams read 5-6 hours per day. Make notes. Every paragraph has important points. Plan your schedule. If plan A fails, try plan B. Don't focus on marks. Try to earn knowledge. Don't expect results just do your sincere learning.
