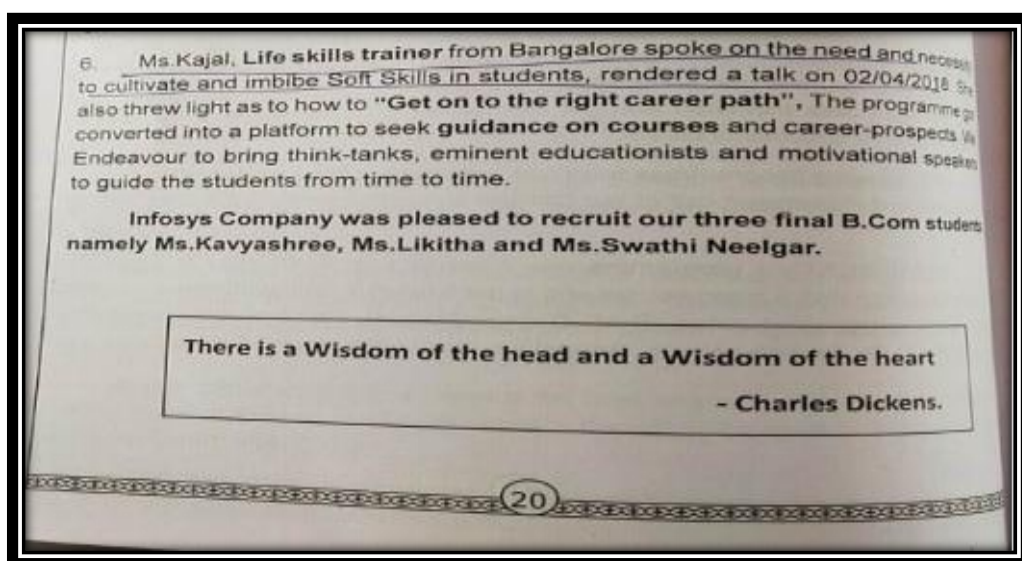



An Inter collegiate quiz competition for the PUC students was conducted on 16th Feb. 2021.





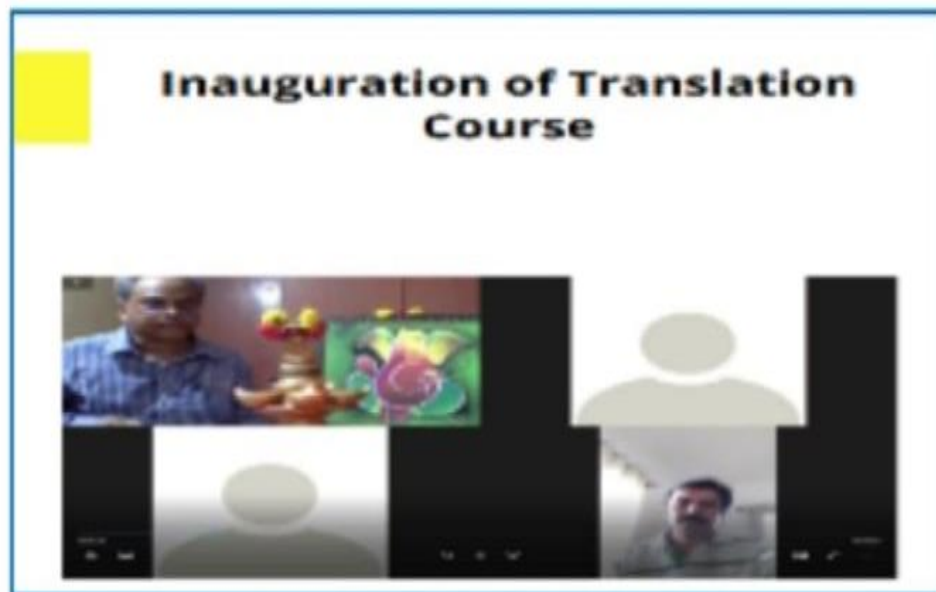
How to prepare google forms

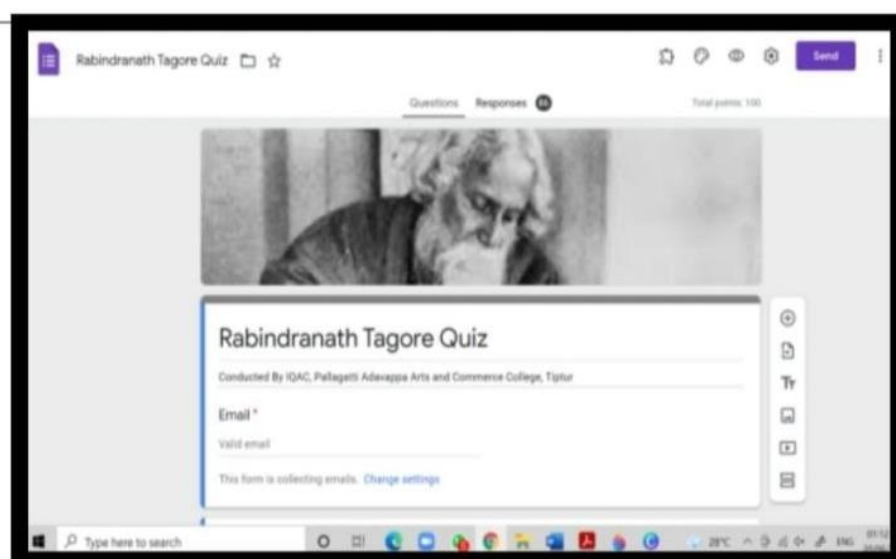
